Letter to patients:

All sick patients are asked to remain in their car and contact the office upon arrival, as we will come to you.

Well visit

Only well visits will be allowed to enter the office at this time. You may wait in your car if desired.

We are now rescheduling the procedures or surgeries that we have had to postpone during this time. You may contact the office or a member of the staff will be in contact with you in the near future.
